

Group Poetry Project



Supplies:

1. One sheet of paper folded into quarters along the width of the paper per group of students. (See image above.)
2. Pencil or pens for each student.

1. Divide students in to groups of four.
2. Give each group a couple of minutes to pick a topic. It can be a word, place, person, animal, song, something in the news, object, movie, etc...
3. The first student will write the first line of the poem on the first fold. When the student is finished, they will hand it to the next student.
4. The second student will read the first line, then fold the first side away so the other writers cannot see it.
5. The second student will write the second line on the next blank section of the folded paper. When the student is finished, they will pass the paper to the third student.
6. The third student will only read the second line of the poem and then write the third line on the next blank section. When finished, the student will pass the paper to the last student.
7. The last student will only read the third line before completing the final line of the poem.
8. Once complete, the students can read their completed poem.
