

Storytelling Fortune

You will need:

Fortune printout (provided in a separate link)

2 dice per group

Divide the class into half, thirds or quarters. Each person in the group will take turns being the storyteller. The storyteller will take a turn rolling the dice and then opening and closing the fortune vertically and horizontally the number of times on the dice. Open the fortune and read the question on the fortune for the number rolled. If the number is greater than six, then subtract the 6 from the total and read the resulting number. For example, if a student rolls an 8, then the student should read number 2. The student then tells a story based on the prompt.

Alternately, each student may take a turn and use the prompt to write a story.

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
